



### Year In Review: Impact the World for Christ

Emmaus remains committed to our mission to glorify God by educating and equipping learners to impact the world for Christ. Here are a few highlights of how we furthered that goal during our 2024 Fiscal Year:

- We applied for, and were subsequently awarded, accreditation to offer graduate level education, beginning with a Master of Arts in Bible & Ministry online through our Emmaus University Global.
- Faculty continue to seek excellence, with 3 recently completing doctoral degrees, and 3 others currently in progress.
- In June 2024, I traveled with a group of students to South Africa as part of our Summer Missions Exposure (Summex) program.
- For the 2nd year in a row, an Emmaus student received the Emerging Scholars Award by the Christian Association of World Languages. Our Bridge English as a Second Language program gives students the opportunity to teach English, using the Bible, to global learners.

Please pray with us for the Lord's continued guidance and provisions as we launch the new MA and transition to Emmaus University in 2025.

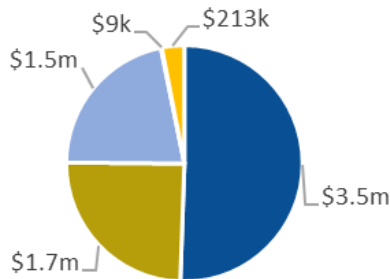

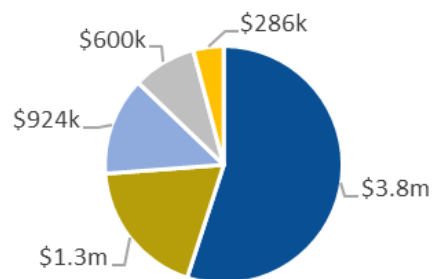

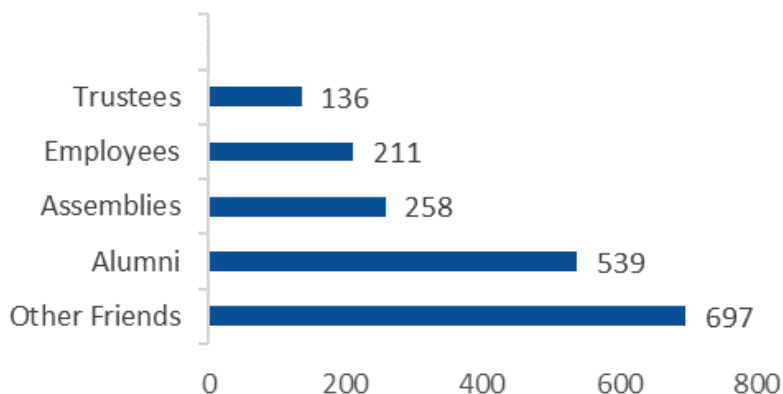
