4. The student will be able to demonstrate their knowledge of two or more cross references in Scripture for each of the 10 problems dealt with in I Corinthians.

**Reading Assignments:**

1. The textbook is I Corinthians by Leon Morris, W. B. Eerdmans Publishing Co. 1958. You are expected to read the entire commentary. (40 points)
2. Each student is required to read the entire book of I Corinthians three (3) times during the semester. It is advised that three different translations be used. (60 points)

An honor statement will be signed the last day of class, to substantiate the completion of these assignments.
