The student will be given a detailed study of the life of Christ, stressing the chronological and geographical aspects of the Lord's ministry as He offers the Kingdom to Israel with its subsequent rejection.

The academic objectives are:

- to understand the geographical movements in the life of Christ
- to understand the nature of the Kingdom message as proclaimed by Christ and His disciples
- to understand the strategy of evangelization employed throughout the ministry of Christ
- to understand the dispensational distinctions as found in the life of Christ

The applicational objectives are:

- to understand the principles for living from the life of Christ with a view to imitation
- to appreciate the soteriological purpose of Christ's life with a view to worship and thanksgiving
- to evaluate the claims of Christ on the life of the student with a view to service
